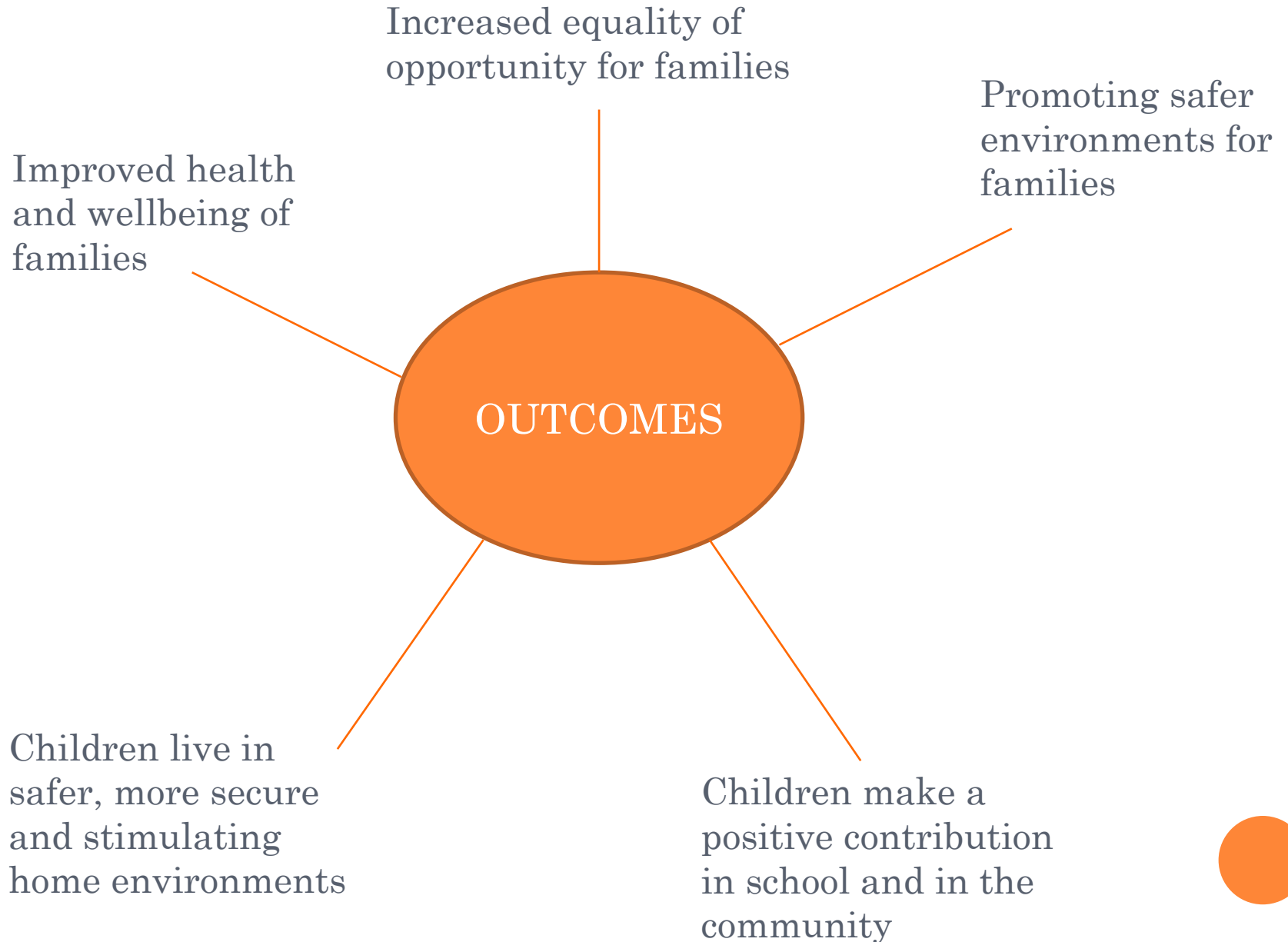

19 carers and 31 children and young people benefitted from an outing to M&D's Theme Park


